

## Philosophy Minor Requirement

The requirement for a Philosophy minor is **18** total credit hours. Students must take 6 courses beyond the GER requirement of PHIL 102 or PHIL 103. The required distribution for these courses:

- PHIL 205: Philosophical Logic
- 2 History courses
- 3 electives from any of the primary groups—Practical, Theoretical, History— more or less evenly distributed, relative to the students interests, and with at least one course each at the 200, 300, 400 levels.
