She started working on climate and pollution issues right out of college with Toxics Action Center, where she helped residents organize campaigns around local pollution threats like dirty fossil fuel power plants and trash incinerators. Her work in Springfield, MA to fight a proposed construction waste incinerator attracted the attention of Gov. Patrick, who suspended the permitting process and, ultimately, the city council voted to kill the project. She also organized with The DC Project, where she recruited more than 100 DC residents to invest in energy efficiency measures in order to build a strong clean energy economy in DC.
