



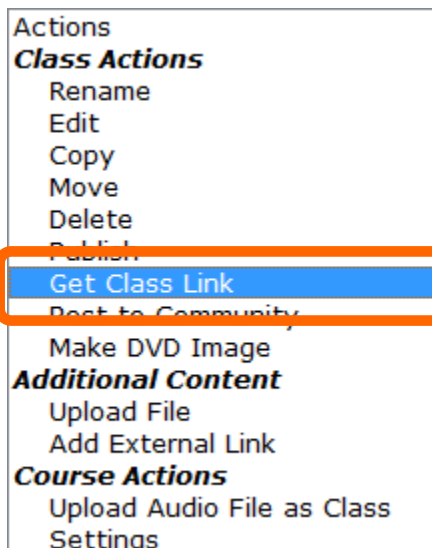
Put a link to a recorded class on a website

A new feature of Tegrity Campus 2.0 is that instructors can make a recorded class available to anyone, not just students in the Blackboard course site, by putting a link to the recorded class on a website. For example, if you record a class presentation that will be useful to students who are interested in taking your class, or even to attract students to the major, you can put a link to that recording on your personal or department website. Follow these instructions to get the URL (web address) of the recorded class.

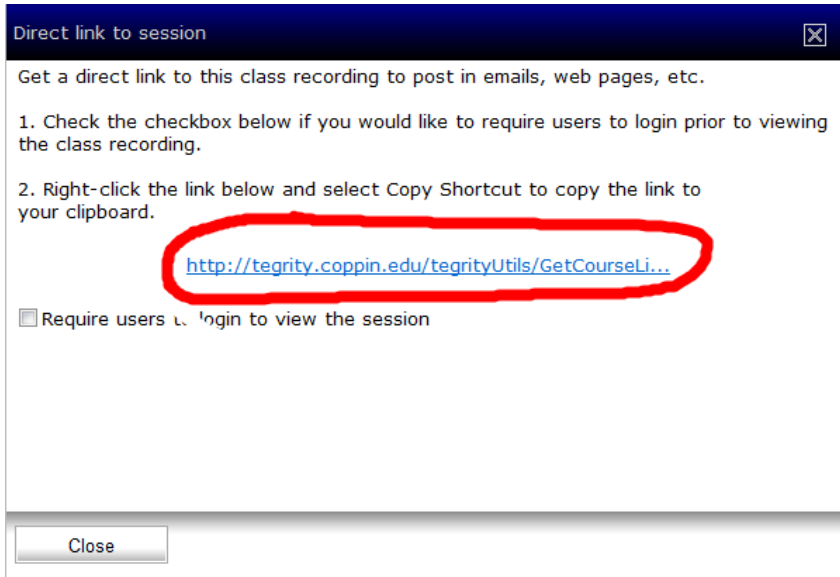
1. Log in to Blackboard <http://eaglebb.coppin.edu>
2. Go to your course site.
3. Click the **Tegrity Classes** link in the left side of the screen.
4. Place a check mark in the box to the left of the recording that you want to make available.

5. In the **Actions** menu in the lower left, select **Get Class Link**.



6. With your mouse, right-click the link in the middle of the window, and select **Copy Shortcut**.



7. Click the **Close** button.
8. Now you need to paste that link into an email message. Open Outlook email and start a new mail message.
9. To paste the link to the class, go to the **Edit** menu and select **Paste**, or press CTRL V on the keyboard.

The link will look like the following:
