is accepting applications for eligible high school seniors
interested in dual enrollment.

Students concurrently enrolled at CSU can take advantage of:

- ▶ Innovative technological access
- ▶ Interactive classroom instruction
- ▶ Access to nationally recognized scholars, researchers and professors
- ▶ Development of critical academic skills
- ▶ Seamless transition as you move from high school to college

To apply for dual enrollment, students must submit a:

1. Completed application & essay about their academic plan to participate in the program
2. High school transcript with a minimum cumulative 3.0 GPA
3. Letter of reference from a high school teacher
4. Signed authorization form from high school administrator or designee
5. Signed letter of agreement and permission form from parents or legal guardians

Eligibility Requirements

For consideration, the student:

- ▶ must be a permanent resident of Maryland
- ▶ must be attending a secondary school in Maryland
- ▶ if home schooled, must submit compliance documentation with state guidelines
- ▶ must meet program criteria as established by CSU

Cost: Students are subject to meet all CSU regulations, including *payment of tuition, fees and associated costs* related to class registration.
