Cynthia Munshell, a licensed psychologist in Maryland since 1993, earned her PhD from the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill and completed her clinical internship at the Duke University-affiliated VA Medical Center in Durham, NC.

Dr. Munshell serves as the Clinical Internship Coordinator for the Applied Psychology and Rehabilitation Counseling program at Coppin State University. She teaches a variety of courses with a clinical and research focus as well as a seminar focused on the internship experience.

While she has training and experience in working with children, families, couples, and pregnant substance abusers, her recent clinical focus has been on older adults.
