85.0 III-5.10 POLICY CONCERNING THE SCHEDULING OF ACADEMIC ASSIGNMENTS ON DATES OF RELIGIOUS OBSERVANCE

(Approved by the Board of Regents, January 11, 1990)

It is the policy of the Board of Regents that the academic programs and services of Coppin State University (CSU) shall be available to all qualified students who have been admitted to its programs, regardless of their religious beliefs. Students shall not be penalized because of observances of their religious holidays and shall be given an opportunity, whenever feasible, to make up within a reasonable time any academic assignment that is missed due to individual participation in religious observances.

CSU has adopted the above language as its guideline and process for faculty and administration. Faculty and administrators shall uphold the policy and use their discretion when scheduling assignments during religious observances. All new and appropriate faculty, administrative and student media shall contain a copy of this policy which shall be disseminated to the campus community.
