## WHAT'S COOKING IN THE RESIDENCE HALL?

### Microwave 4-minute BBQ Chicken Nachos

Mix the chicken with the barbecue sauce, then spread evenly over a bed of tortilla chips. Spread the pico de gallo, cheese, and green onions evenly on top, then microwave for about 1-3 minutes until the cheese is melted and bubbly. Dollop with some guacamole and sour cream, then serve. brown, then drain on a paper towel. Serve with marinara.

- 1 cup rotisserie chicken, shredded
- 3 tablespoons BBQ sauce
- 2 large handfuls tortilla chips
- ¼ cup pico de gallo
- 1 cup shredded cheddar cheese
- ¼ cup green onion, thinly sliced
- guacamole, to serve
- sour cream, to serve
