

Quarterly Higher Education Emergency Student Relief Fund (HEERF) Report

Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act (CRRSAA) and American Rescue Plan (ARP)

Report Date: June 13, 2021

Under CRRSAA and ARP (a)(1) programs, student portion funds must be used to provide financial aid grants to students (including students exclusively enrolled in distance education) which may be used for any component of the student’s cost of attendance or for emergency costs that arise due to coronavirus, such as tuition, food, housing, health care (including mental health care), or childcare. In making financial aid grants to students, the University must prioritize grants to students with exceptional need. Coppin State University (CSU) has signed and returned the Certification and Agreement and the assurance that the institution has used the applicable amount of funds designated under the CRRSAA and ARP (a)(1) and (a)(4) programs to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students.

For CRRSAA funds, CSU recognizes that all students enrolled as of the award date of CRRSAA (May 14, 2021) were affected by the COVID-19 pandemic and therefore provided a pre-determined amount to all eligible students based on credit load status. Full time students received \$840 and part-time students received \$445. As of the date of this report, CSU is in the process of developing the method that will be used to disburse emergency grants to students under the ARP program. CSU is also in the process of developing instructions, directions, or guidance to students concerning the emergency financial aid grants under the ARP program.
